Additional Items

Lunch Hot lunches (including condiments and utensils) are catered to the school each day. A monthly menu is provided to families in advance, and lunch orders can be placed at <u>www.boonli.com</u>. The cost per serving is roughly \$10 at the time of this publication. Students are, of course, welcome to bring their own sack lunch.

Uniform NCA students are required to wear school uniforms. Various uniforms for school days and PE can be purchased at a designated uniform store (to be announced later).

Other Fees Parents are responsible for other costs related to sports participation or any special events outside of school (i.e, Math Olympics, Spelling Bee, etc.). NCA only requests actual costs of participation.

Admission Deadlines for New Students/Families

Regular Admissions

- Application Deadline: January 20
- Notification of Admissions Decision: January 30
- Registration Fee Due: \$2500 within 5 days of receiving admissions acceptance (\$200 reduction)

Rolling Admissions

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee Due: \$2700 within 5 days of receiving admissions acceptance

Mid-Year Transfers/Admissions

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee Due: prorated from \$2700

Kindergarten Applications

Kindergarten applicants are typically assessed for developmental readiness as part of the admissions process. Our Admissions Director will schedule your child's assessment date/time and method.

Grades 1-5 Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or up to previous 3 years' grades and/or report cards

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer its own assessments. The testing fee is included in the application fee. An interview is required.

Grades 6 and Above Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Confidential counselor or administrator recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or up to previous 3 years' grades and/or report cards

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer its own assessments. The testing fee is included in the application fee. An interview is required.

Scholarships

NCA provides generous scholarships to PKs (children of full-time pastors) or MKs (children of full-time missionaries or such missionaries on sabbatical) who have proven track records and potential for advancement.
